## **Required Documentation - EXPORT**

- **PASSPORT** - Photocopy **from front to back, every single page (even covers)**, of shippers or shippers passport or passports, in case they have from more than one country, and have them notarized by a Public Notary (Escribano Público)

**Important:** passports have to be valid and must show any entries and exits, during the last year prior to shipment of your personal goods. In case of a new passport, the need of previous passport is necessary, which should also be photocopied and notarized as well.

- **DNI – Documento Nacional de Identidad or CI – Cedula de Identidad** of the shipper. Photocopy of all pages, front to back.

- **Consular Certificate** - Consulate of the country shipper is moving to, needs to issue a Consular Certificate, stating that the individual is moving for the purpose of permanent residence. For the United States, it's not necessary.

- **Authorization Letter** – Shipper to sign an authorization letter, enabling our company to perform the Customs clearance on his behalf. Same has to be notarized by Public Notary (Escribano Publico)

- **Sworn Statement** - A sworn statement has to be prepared and signed by shipper, in which it states that he has not sent any shipment of personal goods within the last year and that he won't carry any works of art, antiques older than 100 years, etc.

- **Packing List / Inventory** – An itemized and valued inventory is required. Some countries require same to be signed by the Consulate.

- **Airline ticket** – Shipper needs to photocopy his/her airline ticket and have it notarized by Public Notary (Escribano Publico).

- **Contact details** - Contact address and telephone at destination.

**VEHICLES, etc** : Cars, motorcycles, boats and other effects with motors/registration, have to be cleared separately from the personal goods.

**VERY IMPORTANT:** All documentations signed and notarized abroad, Public Notary's signature has to be authenticated by the Argentine Consulate. The Argentine Consul's signature, in turn has to also be authenticated at the Foreign Office in Buenos Aires, for validation.
